Our competences	<p>Alterre Bourgogne is a French non-profit organisation (« association ») which was created in 2006. Its scale of intervention is Burgundy. It is mainly funded by the Regional Council of Burgundy, the French Government, the Agency of the Environment and the Control of Energy (ADEME) and the European Regional Development Fund (FEDER). Alterre's main mission is to place environmental and sustainable development related issues and challenges on the top of the agenda of local public authorities. The wide range of actions that are implemented by Alterre are mainly oriented towards three directions: observation of both the state and the evolution of the environment; technical advice and methodological support provided to actors in charge of public projects in the fields of environment and sustainable development ; and education and public awareness. Alterre provides a platform to all relevant actors of the region and aims at facilitating not only dialogue and debate, but also the establishment and implementation of multi-stakeholders projects in various fields such as energy, climate change, waste, ecosystems, territorial approaches of sustainable development (local Agenda 21), etc. In relation to energy, Alterre helps the Burgundy region in its policy definition by providing data and analysis that constitute tools to aid in decisions. As an observatory, Alterre has been monitoring regional energy consumptions and productions for years. Since 2012, Alterre also takes care of renewable energies, producing shared and collective analysis as well as prospective studies, and promoting innovative solutions. In addition, Alterre helps - and provide training - local territories that are committed in climate plans with the evaluation of their actions, and assists Burgundy with the implementation of the regional climate-air-energy scheme, the framework document aiming at implementing both the national and the EU legislations. Last, Alterre is a resource center and provides information to whoever needs it, on main environmental and sustainable development issues in Burgundy. All its publications and productions are available both on line on its website (http://www.alterre-bourgogne.org) and in print version at its documentation center located within its office in Dijon.</p>
