<b>Title of the proposal/project</b>	PHC 22-2015: Promoting mental wellbeing in the ageing population
<b>Brief profile of the organisation/group</b>	<p>The University Pablo de Olavide of Seville (Spain) is a public university located in a single campus equipped with the latest technologies. The University Pablo de Olavide (UPO) is in a strong position within the framework of the Spanish universities for scientific productivity, one of the highest in Spain, for its leadership in R + D + I projects, as well as in graduate studies and training of researchers. This is recognized in independent rankings developed in recent years (Buela-Casal and colleagues, Psicothema 2012, vol.24, p.505.).</p> <p>The investigation group in Social Work and Social Politics PAI SEJ – 452 is aiming its research to the real needs of elderly citizens nowadays. Important lines of investigation are the analysis of social life in the urban environment and the relation of social life and dependency (this research in collaboration with the Seville city administration). Resuming: there are two lines of investigation: dependency and disability, and elderly citizens. Regarding the scientific-technological services it is necessary to refer to the instruments to manage Social Work intervention in centers and services destineted to senior citizenship members.</p> <p>Some components of this investigation group have created a post-graduate study program, the official Master in Gerontology and Direction and Management of Gerontological centers at the University Pablo de Olavide, which is now starting its 4th edition in 2014. In its study program, it offers a general perspective about the process of growing old on one side, putting emphasis on the other side in special resources dedicated to mentally ill people (here especially dementia) and the people who provide care to them. Among the major purposes of the Master Program are the specific points of view of social politics, social services and social welfare in the context of the elder population. At the same time the program</p>

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	<p>offers the introduction in study and research of gerontological issues, and the establishment of good practice. The Master Program encourages the scientific development of those students interested in following a PhD program afterwards (nowadays, there are 13 PhD with themes related to senior citizens).</p> <p>The group can count on the support of a significant number of public and private institutions: Dirección General de Personas Mayores de la Junta de Andalucía, Consejería de Igualdad, Salud y Bienestar Social de la Junta de Andalucía, Servicio Andaluz de Salud, university courses for elderly at the UPO, Prisons, Mass Media (El Correo de Andalucía), public elderly homes, El Roble (private elderly home), SARquavita private elderly home, the association INTAP, etc.</p>
