

Project title	A project of peace and hospitality between culture and history
Theme	Starting from the past where citizens - young students, soldiers and artists like U. Saba (IT), Zoran Mušič (SI), Hartung (DE), Serrano (ES), Arp (AT), were considered opponents by totalitarian regimes during the holocaust and WW2, the project investigates documents and works where they expressed themselves to convey the terrible history and overcome the trauma. We investigate also the letters where they debated peacefully on European issues, “reborned” to life from the prejudices. We are interesting to share how the past is a lesson for a future of peace, democracy and tolerance with new “European Citizens” concept.
Call for proposal	Europe for Citizen 2014-2020, Strand 1 “European Remembrance”.
Project objectives	The project aims to contribute to citizens' understanding of the Union, its history and diversity. Raise awareness of remembrance, common history and values and the Union's aim that is to promote peace, its values and the well-being of its peoples by stimulating debate, reflection, development of networks with new citizens of Europe and new States in the “Europe for Citizens” Programme. Starting from the historical facts of the citizens, students or artists like Saba, Hartung, Mušič etc., that met peacefully in Lendinara, we’ll take lessons for the future. We are looking for partners that want to share the remembrance of citizens believed opponents, which reacted to the trauma with works like writings, paintings, flyers etc, to prove that peaceful coexistence is possible. The project’s initiatives are: workshops, conferences, lessons with survivors, Festival between different cultures, research, exhibition, dvd.
Information about lead partner	Lendinara Municipality is a city near Venice in Italy, with ca 12.000 inhabitants. Situated in the area of the River Po, there are many historical sites and cultural events like “Solstice Festival”. The Municipality organizes info-day with ECP Italy, promotes policies of inclusion and exchanges with citizens from different States, EU and non-EU. The Municipality was really active in the past, hosting famous artists of the period coming from different States, and also groups of youth students during the Second World War that didn’t believe in war. The Municipality supports the numerous local associations of citizens active in dance, research, for the preservation of tangible and intangible heritage. In the town lived also Jessie White Mario (UK) first woman reporter that writes about the difficult lives of children and active for the ideals of freedom and well-being of the poorest citizens with Garibaldi.
